Edwin Lee Winner of the 1998-1999 Lionti-Lewis Concerto Competition



Edwin Lee, 17, has been studying the violin under the direction of Ms. Naoko Tanaka at the Juilliard School Pre-College Division since 1993. Since the age of five, he has had extensive experience in orchestral playing, as well as solo performances. His most recent experience includes serving as concertmaster of the Westchester Junior Strings and Youth Symphony, as well as the Westchester County Intermediate All-County (1995) and Area All-State (1997) orchestras. He plays or has played in several other orchestras, including the two orchestras at Scarsdale High School, which he currently attends, the Juilliard Pre-College Orchestra, and the NYSSMA Conference All-State Sumphony (1997) and String Orchestra (1998). Edwin has given recitals at Weill Recital Hall and at Morse Hall in the Juilliard School, and in 1997 he performed the Tchaikovsky Violin Concerto with the Yonkers Philharmonic Orchestra under Maestro Jerome Sala. At the Enrico Fermi Concerto Competition, he was awarded second place in 1997, and he also received a "best overall performance" award at the Cultural Heritage Competition. Edwin enjoys playing chamber music, having played in ensembles at school, at the Aspen Music Festival (1995), and at the Hamptons Summer Music Festival (1996). Edwin shares this year's Lionti-Lewis Concerto Competition award with Christina Guarino.

Christina Guarino has been playing French horn for eight years. She studied with Dolores Beck Schwartz of Putnam Valley for seven years and is currently working with Michelle Baker of the Metropolitan Opera Orchestra. Christina's musical experiences include performing with the All-State Symphonic Band and the Young Artist Orchestra at Tanglewood. This will be her first solo performance with orchestra. In addition to studying at the Manhattan School of Music Preparatory Division, Christina is planning to pursue music performance after graduation in June. Christina shares this year's Lionti-Lewis Concerto Competition award with Edwin Lee.
