### About The Artists

Bernard Klinger is a graduate of Hartt College of Music, where he received bachelors degrees in Viola Performance, and in Music Education. He received an M.A. in Music Education from Teachers College, Columbia University. Mr. Klinger teaches elementary strings and orchestra in the Chappaqua Central Schools, a position he has held since 1979. Previously, he taught music in the White Plains Schools for seven years. He was principal violist in the Ridgefield, Ct. Symphony, and currently plays viola in the Greenwich Symphony. A Past President of the Westchester County School Music Association (WCSMA), he has also served as Elementary Festival Coordinator, orchestra chairman, and in 1991 was the conductor of the Elementary Orchestra. Active in GWYOA, Mr. Klinger has been Vice President of the Board of Directors, led sectional rehearsals, judged concerto competitions, and served as substitute conductor of the Elementary and Junior Strings.

Jacqueline Stern has been working with young musicians as a conductor, cello instructor, and chamber music coach. Presently, she conducts the orchestra at the Green Meadow Waldorf School. She was the associate director of the Suzuki program at Queensborough Community College from 1989-1993. She is a performing cellist with the Hudson String Quartet and has worked with groups that include the Stamford Symphony, the Artek Ensemble, the New York City Opera, the Holy Trinity Bach Orchestra and the Washington Bach Consort. Ms. Stern has a music education degree from Ithaca College and a master's degree in performance from the Manhattan School of Music.


Vincent J. Lionti has been a member of the Metropolitan Opera Orchestra since 1987. From 1983-1987 he was a member of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra; he performed with the New York Philharmonic form 1981-1983. In 1991, he was principal violist with the Sante Fe Opera and guest principal violist of the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra. He also has been a member of the Casals Festival Orchestra, the Lyric Chamber Ensemble and the Renaissance City Chamber Ensemble. Mr. Lionti holds B. Mus. and M.M. degrees from Juilliard School, where he was principal violist and teaching assistant to William Lincer.

Meaghan Stecich Burke, 16 years old, has played cello with the GWYOA since 1995. Last month, she performed in the All-State String Orchestra and was principal cellist in the Area All-State Orchestra. Last spring, she was a finalist in the Enrico Fermi Concerto Competition. Meaghan has studied piano since she was 6. She also sings and was a member of last year's All-State Women's Chorus. Meaghan studies cello with David Krieger and piano with Joanne Procell, who is also her accompanist. Meaghan is a senior at Ardsley High School, where she is currently first in her class and a National Merit Semifinalist. She is active in the school's drama program and hopes to pursue music and drama in college.
