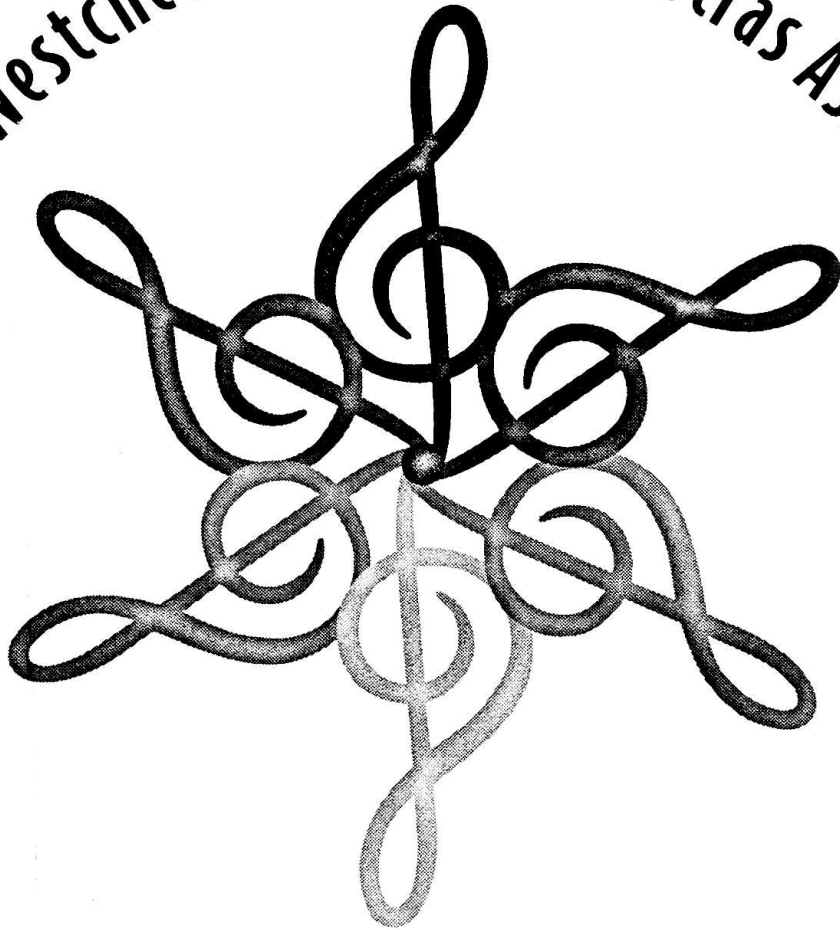

About the Conductors

Bernard Klinger is a graduate of Hartt College of Music, where he received Bachelors degrees in Viola performance and Music Education. He has a Masters degree in Music Education from Teachers College, Columbia University. Mr. Klinger currently teaches strings and orchestra at Holland Hill School in Fairfield, Connecticut. Previously, he taught strings and orchestra in the Chappaqua, NY schools for 26 years and in the White Plains, NY schools for seven years. He was principal violist in the Ridgefield, Ct. Symphony, and currently plays viola in the Greenwich Symphony. A past president of the Westchester County School Music Association (WCSMA), he has also served as Elementary Festival Coordinator, orchestra chairman, Elementary Orchestra Conductor and Advisor to the Board. Mr. Klinger joined GWYOA in 1996 and this year celebrates his 10th year conducting Elementary Strings.

Jacqueline Stern has a music education degree from Ithaca College and a Masters degree in performance from the Manhattan School of Music. She has been working with young musicians as a conductor, cello instructor and chamber music coach. Presently, she conducts the orchestra at the Green Meadow Waldorf School. Ms. Stern was the associate director of the Suzuki program at Queensborough Community College from 1989-1993. She is a performing cellist with the Hudson String Quartet and has worked with groups that include the Stamford Symphony, the Artek Ensemble, the New York City Opera, the Holy Trinity Bach Orchestra and the Washington Bach Consort. Ms. Stern has conducted for GWYOA for 23 years, starting the Elementary Strings in 1983 and then taking over as Junior Strings conductor in 1996.

Vincent J. Lioni holds a Bachelors degree of Music and Masters degree of Music from The Juilliard School where he was principal violist and teaching assistant to William Lincer. He has been a member of the Metropolitan Opera Orchestra since 1987. From 1983-1987 he was a member of the Detroit Symphony and he performed with the New York Philharmonic from 1981-1983. Mr Lioni has performed as the principal violist with the Santa Fe Opera and guest principal violist of the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra. He has also been a member of the Casals Festival Orchestra, the Lyric Chamber Ensemble and the Renaissance City Chamber Ensemble. Mr. Lioni has had a long history with GWYOA, first as a student at age 12, through high school, and now as a conductor. He has led Junior Strings and then the Youth Symphony for 16 years.

C. Victor Lioni was Musical Director and Conductor of the Westchester Youth Symphony for 27 years until 1997. His teaching career has included: Hartford High School, White Plains High School and Kent State University. He was on the faculty of Westchester Community College for 25 years where he served as Music Curriculum Chairman, and remains as Professor Emeritus and Adjunct Professor of Music. A graduate of the Eastman School of Music and the Catholic University of America, Mr. Lioni has performed with the Rochester Philharmonic, the Hartford Symphony, the US Marine Band in Washington DC and as Principal Violist with the Greenwich Symphony. Mr. Lioni was Music Director of the Aaron Copland Music and Arts Program in Westchester County. He presently serves as Co-ordinator and Associate Conductor for the GWYOA Youth Symphony..
