About the Conductors

Bernard Klinger is a graduate of Hartt College of Music where he received Bachelors Degrees in Music Education and Viola Performance. He has an Masters degree in Music Education from Columbia University Teachers College. Mr. Klinger currently teaches strings and orchestra at Holland Hill School in Fairfield, Connecticut Previously, he taught strings and orchestra in the Chappaqua and White Plains School Districts for 33 years. He was principal violist in the Ridgefield, Ct. Symphony, and currently plays viola in the Greenwich Symphony. A past president of the Westchester County School Music Association (WCSMA), he has also served as Elementary Festival Coordinator, orchestra chairman, Elementary Orchestra Conductor and advisor to the board. Mr. Klinger joined GWYOA in 1996.

Jacqueline Stern has a Bachelors Degree in Music Education from Ithaca College and a Master's Degree in Cello Performance from the Manhattan School of Music. She currently conducts the orchestras at the Green Meadow Waldorf School. She is a performing cellist with the Hudson String Quartet and has performed with the New York City Opera, the Artek Ensemble and the Stamford Symphony. Ms. Stern joined the GWYOA as conductor of the Elementary Strings in 1983. She has been serving in her current role as Conductor of the GWYOA Junior Strings since 1997.

About the Conductors

Vincent J. Lionti holds a Bachelors degree of Music and Masters degree of Music from The Juilliard School where he was principal violist and teaching assistant to William Lincer. He has been a member of the Metropolitan Opera Orchestra since 1987. From 1983-1987 he was a member of the Detroit Symphony and he performed with the New York Philharmonic from 1981-1983. Mr Lionti has performed as the principal violist with the Santa Fe Opera and guest principal violist of the Indian apolis Symphony Orchestra. He has also been a member of the Casals Festival Orchestra, the Lyric Chamber Ensemble and the Renaissance City Chamber Ensemble. Mr. Lionti has had a long history with GWYOA, first as a student at age 12, through high school, and now as a conductor. He has led the Westchester Junior Strings and then the West chester Youth Symphony for 16 years.

chester Youth Symphony for 27 years until 1997. His teaching career has included: Hartford High School, White Plains High School and Kent State University. He was on the faculty of Westchester Community College for 25 years where he served as Music Curriculum Chairman, and remains as Professor Emeritus and Adjunct Professor of Music. A graduate of the Eastman School of Music and the Catholic University of America, Mr. Lionti has performed with the Rochester Philharmonic, the Hartford Symphony, the US Marine Band in Washington DC and as Principal Violist with the Greenwich Symphony. Mr. Lionti was Music Director of the Aaron Copland Music and Arts Program in Westchester County. He presently serves as Co-ordinator and Associate Conductor for the GWYOA Youth Symphony.

The Lionti-Lewis Concerto Competition

The Lionti-Lewis Concerto Competition was established by the GWYOA Board of Directors in 1997. The competition gives outstanding Youth Symphony seniors an opportunity to perform a major concerto with full orchestral accompaniment. They also receive a scholarship award. In addition to recognizing the musical accomplishments of our students, the competition was established to honor the many years of dedicated GWYOA service rendered by Dale Lewis, former director of the Junior Strings, and Victor Lionti, currently associate conductor of the Youth Symphony. This year we are honored to present the 2006 Lionti-Lewis Concerto Competition winner, Stephen Benedict.

Stephen Benedict, now 17 years old, has played cello since he was eight and has been a member of GWYOA since 2001. Last month he performed in the All-State String Orchestra and was principal cellist in the Area All-State Orchestra. Stephen has been a participant in the Summit Music Festival for 4 years. He currently studies with Kevork Parsamian at the Manhattan School of Muisc. A senior at Scarsdale High School, Stephen is also a member of the National Honor Society. He intends to continue playing cello in college, where he plans to major in Asian Studies and Linguistics.
