ABOUT THE CONDUCTORS

Bernard Klinger is a graduate of Hartt College of Music where he received Bachelors Degrees in Music Education and Viola Performance. He has an Masters degree in Music Education from Columbia University Teachers College. Mr. Klinger currently teaches strings and orchestra at Holland Hill School in Fairfield, Connecticut. Previously, he taught strings and orchestra in the Chappaqua and White Plains School Districts for 33 years. He was principal violist in the Ridgefield, Ct. Symphony, and currently plays viola in the Greenwich Symphony. A past president of the Westchester County School Music Association (WCSMA), he has also served as Elementary Festival Coordinator, orchestra chairman, Elementary Orchestra Conductor and advisor to the board. Mr. Klinger joined GWYOA in 1996.

Jacqueline Stern has a Bachelors Degree in Music Education from Ithaca College and a Master's Degree in Cello Performance from the Manhattan School of Music. She currently conducts the orchestras at the Green Meadow Waldorf School. She is a performing cellist with the Hudson String Quartet and has performed with the New York City Opera, the Artek Ensemble and the Stamford Symphony. Ms. Stern joined the GWYOA as conductor of the Elementary Strings in 1983. She has been serving in her current role as Conductor of the GWYOA Junior Strings since 1997.

Vincent J. Lionti holds a Bachelors degree of Music and Masters degree of Music from The Juilliard School where he was principal violist and teaching assistant to William Lincer. He has been a member of the Metropolitan Opera Orchestra since 1987. From 1983-1987 he was a member of the Detroit Symphony and he performed with the New York Philharmonic from 1981-1983. Mr Lionti has performed as the principal violist with the Santa Fe Opera and guest principal violist of the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra. He has also been a member of the Casals Festival Orchestra, the Lyric Chamber Ensemble and the Renaissance City Chamber Ensemble. Mr. Lionti has had a long history with GWYOA, first as a student at age 12, through high school, and now as a conductor.

He has led the Westchester Junior Strings and then the Westchester Youth Symphony for 16 years.

C. Victor Lionti was Musical Director and Conductor of the West-chester Youth Symphony for 27 years until 1997. His teaching career has included: Hartford High School, White Plains High School and Kent State University. He was on the faculty of Westchester Community College for 25 years where he served as Music Curriculum Chairman, and remains as Professor Emeritus and Adjunct Professor of Music. A graduate of the Eastman School of Music and the Catholic University of America, Mr. Lionti has performed with the Rochester Philharmonic, the Hartford Symphony, the US Marine Band in Washington DC and as Principal Violist with the Greenwich Symphony. Mr. Lionti was Music Director of the Aaron Copland Music and Arts Program in Westchester County. He presently serves as Co-ordinator and Associate Conductor for the GWYOA Youth Symphony.

Catarina Longhi is a senior at Carmel High School in Putnam County. She is in her third year of studies at the Juilliard Pre-College Division. She previously studied violin with Margaret Ziemnicka and viola with Edward Malave at the Music Conservatory of Westchester. Caterina is in her eighth year as a violinist for the Westchester Youth Symphony. She has also been a violist in the New York Youth Symphony for four years. Her chamber music ensemble, Molto Semplice, was one of only two groups chosen unanimously to play at Weill Recital Hall by the New York Youth Symphony Chamber Music Program in their 41st season. She has served as principal violist of the Full Orchestra of the New York State Summer School of Orchestral Studies for two years and she has earned 1st chair at the All-State Conference in Rochester. She has also been principal of Area All-State for 3 years. Last year she was one of four violists chosen to participate in the first chamber music pilot program at Juilliard. Caterina's quartet studied under Ms. Bonnie Hampton and it was selected to represent the Pre-College Division for the Juilliard National Council in 2008. In the fall she will be attending Juilliard, studying under Heidi Castleman and Steven Tenenbom
