ABOUT THE CONDUCTORS

Bernard Klinger is a graduate of Hartt College of Music where he received Bachelors Degrees in Music Education and Viola Performance. He has a Masters degree in Music Education from Columbia University Teachers College. Mr. Klinger currently teaches strings and orchestra at Holland Hill School in Fairfield, Connecticut. Previously, he taught strings and orchestra in the Chappaqua and White Plains School Districts for 33 years. He was principal violist in the Ridgefield, Ct. Symphony, and currently plays viola in the Greenwich Symphony. A past president of the Westchester County School Music Association (WCSMA), he has also served as Elementary Festival Coordinator, orchestra chairman, Elementary Orchestra Conductor and advisor to the board. Mr. Klinger joined GWYOA in 1996.

Jacqueline Stern has a Bachelors Degree in Music Education from Ithaca College and a Master's Degree in Cello Performance from the Manhattan School of Music. She currently conducts the orchestras at the Green Meadow Waldorf School. She is a performing cellist with the Hudson String Quartet and has performed with the New York City Opera, the Artek Ensemble and the Stamford Symphony. Ms. Stern joined the GWYOA as conductor of the Elementary Strings in 1983. She has been serving in her current role as Conductor of the GWYOA Junior Strings since 1997.

Vincent J. Lionti holds a Bachelors degree of Music and Masters degree of Music from The Juilliard School where he was principal violist and teaching assistant to William Lincer. He has been a member of the Metropolitan Opera Orchestra since 1987. From 1983-1987 he was a member of the Detroit Symphony and he performed with the New York Philharmonic from 1981-1983. Mr Lionti has performed as the principal violist with the Santa Fe Opera and guest principal violist of the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra. He has also been a member of the Casals Festival Orchestra, the Lyric Chamber Ensemble and the Renaissance City Chamber Ensemble. Mr. Lionti has had a long history with GWYOA, first as a student at age 12, through high school, and now as a conductor. He has led the Westchester Junior Strings and then the Westchester Youth Symphony for 16 years.

C. Victor Lionti was Musical Director and Conductor of the Westchester Youth Symphony for 27 years until 1997. His teaching career has included: Hartford High School, White Plains High School and Kent State University. He was on the faculty of Westchester Community College for 25 years where he served as Music Curriculum Chairman, and remains as Professor Emeritus and Adjunct Professor of Music. A graduate of the Eastman School of Music and the Catholic University of America, Mr. Lionti has performed with the Rochester Philharmonic, the Hartford Symphony, the US Marine Band in Washington DC and as Principal Violist with the Greenwich Symphony. Mr. Lionti was Music Director of the Aaron Copland Music and Arts Program in Westchester County. He presently serves as Coordinator and Associate Conductor for the GWYOA Youth Symphony.

Elbert Heng, 17 years old, has been playing cello under the guidance of Mr. Frederick Ostrofsky for ten years, and has been a member of GWYOA since 2002. In 2008, Elbert was the principal cellist of the Westchester Area All-State Orchestra. He has performed at the Eastman Theatre in 2008 and 2009 with the New York Conference All State Orchestra. A senior at Yorktown High School, Elbert is the salutatorian of his class and a National Merit Scholarship Semifinalist. He intends to continue playing cello throughout his life, and aims to attend medical school.

Stephanie Stoisits, a sixth-year classical flute student at the Manhattan School of Music Pre-College division, currently studies with Susan Deaver and Barbara Koskos. She is principal flute in the Putnam Valley H. S. wind ensemble. At the Luzerne Summer Chamber Music Festival she won best chamber group and best solo performance. She has won the United States Military Academy Young Artists' Concerto Competition where she was featured with the USMA Band. Stephanie has attended the New York State School Music Association (NYSSMA) winter conference as part of the All State Orchestra and in 2009 she performed at the MENC Eastern conference. Stephanie plans on continuing her education by pursuing a degree in Music performance.
